INSPIRATIONAL PILGRIMAGE ITINERARY

Day 1**Depart Lagos****Day 2. ARRIVAL - BANIAS - BOAT RIDE -CAPERNAUM - TABGHA - MOUNT OF BEATITUDES**

Upon arrival at Ben Gurion airport you will be met and assisted through the immigration by our representative.

Transfer to your hotel.

At 11:00 Hrs Drive to the Golan Heights to visit the Banias and Caesarea Philippi (Matthew 16:13-20), a source of the Jordan River. Cruise on the Sea of Galilee (John 6:16-21; Matthew 8:23-27). Proceed to visit Capernaum (Mark 1:21-35), a lakeside village frequently referred to in the New Testament as home to St. Peter and a site built atop of a synagogue said to be where Jesus Christ preached. View to the east the ruins of Bethsaida (John 1:44; Matthew 1:20-24). We continue along the shore to Tabgha (John 6:1-15), scene of the Feeding of The Five Thousand. There are two Churches; The Church of the Multiplication on the site of the miracle, and The Church of the Primacy of Peter, (John 21:1-19), Where Jesus restored Peter back to himself and the site of The Miraculous Catch of Fish. Nearby is the village of Magdala, birthplace of Mary Magdalene. We continue to Mount of Beatitudes (Matthew 5:1-16), where tradition places the spot where Jesus delivered the Sermon on the Mount.

Overnight: Tiberias

Day 3. MOUNT CARMEL - MEGIDDO - CANA

Proceed to Mount Carmel (1 Kings 18:16-40) and visit Muhraqa, where Elijah prayed for the defeat of the 450 false Prophets of Ba'al. Onto Megiddo (Revelations 16:16) that was mentioned in Revelations by the name of Armageddon. It is the site of the final confrontation between good and evil. Onto the Arab Christian town of Cana (John 2:1-11), which is scene of Jesus' First Miracle of turning water into wine at the wedding feast.

Overnight: Tiberias

Day 4. YARDENIT - NAZARETH - MOUNT TABOR

Proceed to Yardenit, the baptismal site on the Jordan River (Matthew 3:13-19) where thousands of Christians are baptized and/or renew their baptismal vows.

Continue to Nazareth (Luke 1:26-38), childhood home of Jesus. Visit Mary's Well and The Basilica of the Annunciation with its underground grotto where the Angel Gabriel appeared to Mary and announced the forthcoming birth of Jesus.

Proceed to Mount Tabor (Matthew 17:1-8) where tradition places the miracle of the transfiguration.

Overnight: Tiberias

Day 5. JORDAN VALLEY - JERICHO - DEAD SEA - JERUSALEM

Proceed to Jericho the world's oldest town. See the Mount of Temptation and continue to the Sycamore tree that Zacchaeus climbed to see and hear Jesus.

Continue to the **Dead Sea** area. Have a swim in the therapeutic waters of the Dead Sea. The sea has a high concentration of various healing chemical salts so that one cannot sink in it. Proceed through the Judean Wilderness to Jerusalem.

Overnight: Jerusalem

Day 6. OLD CITY OF JERUSALEM - WESTERN WALL - BETHLEHEM

Enjoy a walking tour of the 'Walled City'. See the Crusader Church of St. Anne, mother of Mary, and the excavated twin Pools of Bethesda where Jesus healed the Crippled (John 5:1-9). Walk along the Via Dolorosa (Mark 15:21-47), the traditional route with its Fourteen Stations along which Jesus carried His cross, to the Church of the Holy Sepulchre built over the site of Golgotha Calvary (Matthew 27:33-62; Mark 15; 22-47; Luke 23:33-56). On to the Western Wall the last remnant of the Temple.

Continue to Bethlehem to visit the Church of the Nativity (Luke 2:1-20), Built over the traditional site of the manger where Jesus Christ was born. Continue to visit the site of the Shepherd's Fields of the Nativity (Luke: 2:8-21). Return to Jerusalem. Overnight: Jerusalem

**Day 7. MOUNT OF OLIVES -
MOUNT ZION - GARDEN TOMB**

We begin our pilgrimage in Jerusalem at the Mount of Olives for a spectacular panoramic view of Jerusalem and the Old City. On the slopes of the Mount of Olives are various small churches commemorating key events in Jesus' later life including the lovely Chapel of Dominus Fleuit (Luke 19:37-44) recalling the spot where Jesus wept over Jerusalem's pending destruction. Here too is the luminous Russian Church. At the foot of the Mount of Olives is the Garden of Gethsemane with its eight olive trees; it was here that Jesus was arrested (Mark 14:32-52; Matthew 26:36-46). Visit the Church of All Nations. Continue to

Mount Zion and visit the Church of St. Peter in Gallicantu (Caiaphas' House), where Jesus was imprisoned and interrogated by the High Priest (Matthew 26:57-75; Mark 14:53-72). Visit the site of King David's Tomb and the Upper Room where the Last Supper took place (Matthew 26:17-35; Mark 14:12-26; Luke 22:7-38). We end the day at Garden Tomb and Gordon's Golgotha for a Communion (John 19:38-42). In the evening JP Ceremony will be at the hotel.

Overnight: Jerusalem

**Day 8. EIN KAREM -ELAH
VALLEY - JAFFA -TEL AVIV-**

After lunch proceed to Ein Kareem (Luke 1:57-80) to visit the

Church of St. John the Baptist, erected over the grotto where he was born. On to Valley of Elah where David's contest with Goliath (Samuel I:17). Continue to the Old town of Jaffa, oldest port city in the world. Here St. Peter had his dream (Acts 10:9-16) to evangelize the Gentiles and where he Brought Tabitha (Acts 9:36-43) back from the dead.

Day 9. Free day for leisure/
Departure in the evening.

Day 10. Arrival - Lagos
